

**Titel:**

The Future of Travel Surveys

**Baggrund:**

A need to find and develop new solutions for travel surveys has been identified in many countries around Europe. The background for this consists in part of declining response rates using current methods, which could lead to problems in terms of representativity, but also a wish to reach higher data quality and the being able to use data that are already at hand. The development of new data collection methods for future travel surveys is viewed as matter of great urgency in both the short and long terms.
