## Link to the future

In recent years, Aalborg has established itself as a city of distinction. A city that takes urban development and sustainability seriously. We remain an attractive destination for a constant stream of students, jobs and tourists. Meanwhile, pressure on the already congested infrastructure in the city centre is mounting. Consequently, we are continuously prioritising sustainability and envisaging mobility-promoting and flexible transport solutions.

## DRIVERLESS AND FOSSIL-FREE PORT TRANSPORT

Fjordbus is a project under the Centre for Logistics and Cooperation to establish a fully electric, autonomous ferry link between Aalborg and Nørresundby. A bus on the water, designed to enhance the mobility of the people of North Jutland, bolster Aalborg as a tourist destination and propel us to the forefront of sustainable maritime development. Benefiting Aalborg, North Jutland and Denmark.

Fjordbus, which is due to be implemented in 2022, will become the first emission-free, autonomous ferry link in Denmark and one of first worldwide



# In the heart of the city

Fjordbus will sail between Musikkens Plads immediately east of the House of Music in Aalborg and Stigsborg Waterfront in Nørresundby. It will be easy to hop on and off also by bike and the trip will only take five minutes.

Upon its completion, the Stigsborg Waterfront development is expected to house 7,500 residents, as well as numerous businesses, cafes and public institutions. Stigsborg Waterfront is an ideal stop for Fjordbus, which will become the obvious transport option for people living and working in the area.

On the Aalborg side, passengers will board and disembark in the heart of the city's cultural centre and the trip will afford a unique opportunity to experience Aalborg's House of Music and waterfront from the water.

#### CLOSER TOGETHER

Just a few years ago, crossing the Limfjord without a car was no simple matter. The fjord acted like a bottleneck that seemed to stretch the distance between Aalborg and Nørresundby.

Fortunately, this is about to change thanks to such initiatives as the Culture Bridge, which has provided new transport opportunities. Along with the planned bicycle and pedestrian bridge between Aalborg C and Stigsborg Brygge, Fjordbus will help to further unite the two cities and enhance the mobility of the people of North Jutland.

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
## Better mobility — better city

Aalborg's infrastructure is under pressure. Consequently, Aalborg Municipality has through its strategy "Mobility 2040" set out a clear direction for the future development of the transport system. We need to improve our movement both sustainably and with greater consideration for the environment, the city and each other. This requires us to think in new ways both figuratively and literally.

Via Fjordbus, we can significantly improve the mobility of the people of North Jutland, providing them a much-needed sustainable transport alternative. It will also afford the individual citizens reduced travel time and greater freedom while positively influencing the current traffic situation in Aalborg.

#### SUSTAINABLE URBAN DEVELOPMENT

Sustainable transport is not merely about reducing the  $CO_2$  emissions of our means of transportation. It is about shortening the distances and ensuring flexibility and diversity. About facilitating our unproblematic movement from A to B and providing a more comprehensive array of transport options. In this respect, Fjordbus will clearly be a part of Aalborg's sustainable development.



### **Positive impacts**

### ALEVIATED CONGESTION ON LIMFJORD BRIDGE

Limfjord Bridge is one the most congested areas in Aalborg Municipality. Fjordbus will constitute an attractive transport alternative for people e.g., commuting to and from work or school.

#### REDUCED TRAFFIC IN THE CITY CENTRE

An increasing number of vehicles on the roads and regular traffic jams on Limfjord Bridge have become a common feature in Aalborg. Fjordbus can alleviate the build-up of traffic and reduce congestion in the city centre.

#### IMPROVED PARKING CONDITIONS

Issues around the availability of parking in Aalborg will also be alleviated by a car-free transport option, especially during such large events as The Tall Ships Races, which further exacerbate the problem.





## A safe and secure journey

Naturally, Fjordbus will be fitted with all necessary and legally required safety equipment. 24-hour camera monitoring by the North Jutland Emergency Management Agency provides additional security to the passengers.

- Fully autonomous, emission-free fjord bus
- Expected lifetime: 15 years
- Capacity: 20-25 passengers
- Space for prams, bicycles and wheelchairs

To discover more about the significance of Fjordbus for the citizens, we conducted a survey in 2019. The response was unequivocal: The people of North Jutland want a fjord bus.



87% are interested in using Fjordbus as an alternative to the Limfjord Tunnel and Bridge.




64% are willing to pay \$3.5 or more for a trip if their waiting time is 15 minutes or less.

#### A TOURIST ATTRACTION

With boarding centrally at Musikkens Plads, Fjordbus will in all probability become a draw for the thousands of tourists who visit the waterfront area, especially during the summer. Not least in connection with such major events as The Tall Ships Races and the DGI National Sports Convention. Aalborg also hosts thousands of tourists from near and far arriving by cruise ship every year.


